All express mail must be left with no acceptance signature required. No hand-delivered entries accepted until 8am Saturday, June 25. Envelopes with more than 10 dogs' entries will be returned. Checks returned for insufficient fees will invalidate the entry; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check, money order, or cash, & received prior to the start of judging.

WAIT LIST: Entries received after the stated entry limits have been reached (but before the closing date/time) will be held on a wait list to a maximum of 50 dogs. If accepted entries are withdrawn before **Monday August 15 at 6pm**, entries on the wait list will be accepted subject to the entry limit. Entries withdrawn prior to the 8/15 6pm deadline *that are replaced by a waitlisted entry* will have entry fees reimbursed in full, as will any unaccepted wait list entries.

Entry forms with email addresses will be sent entry receipts, as well as final confirmations, via email. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, & no further efforts will be made. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing. If receipt of entry notification is desired, a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope must be included with the entry forms.

SITE INFORMATION: Rings will be ~ 72'x115' on grass-like soccer turf. Classes will alternate between the two rings. E-timers will be used in all classes. Nearly 8,000 sq ft of indoor crating space is available upstairs and downstairs. Downstairs crating is for workers and disabled handlers ONLY. Check out www.thinkpawsitivedog.com for more information.

The German Shepherd Dog Club of Wisconsin will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Food and beverages will be available for workers only.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs.

Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

MEASURING: All dogs participating in this trial must have an AKC height card or they will need to be measured prior to running in the trial. A VMO will be in attendance to measure for official height cards. It is the owner's responsibility to have the dog measured prior to running. Awards may be cancelled if the dog is not measured before running.

If your dog does not have a permanent card, does not have a temporary card, or has not been measured twice since turning two years of age, mark "This dog needs to be measured" on the entry form.

Judge, Running Order, Start Times

Judge for all classes: Bob Jeffers, Odessa FL

Start times each day: Armband pickup 7:00 am, Judging 8:00 am

Class order:

Saturday: FAST, M/E Std, M/E JWW, Premier Std, Premier JWW, Open Std, Open JWW, Novice Std, Novice JWW. All classes small to tall.

Sunday: Time 2 Beat, M/E Std, M/E JWW, Premier Std, Premier JWW, Open Std, Open JWW, Novice Std, Novice JWW. All classes tall to small.

MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: If a dog earns an agility title before this event it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 6pm on Monday, August 15 or at the close of the trial on Saturday, August 20 which will be considered the awarding of ribbons for the last class. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. No verbal changes will be accepted.

REFUNDS: No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. Entry fees for bitches that come into season after the closing date will be refunded less \$3/run if notice is given to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging.

RINGSIDE: Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current regulations for Agility Trials. Table and contact obstacles are rubberized and the tire is a breakaway tire.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. GSDCW and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/ Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the first through fourth place teams in each class and height division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. New Title ribbons, Master Double Q ribbons, MACH/PACH rosettes and MACH/PACH bars will be awarded to teams fulfilling those achievements. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial; none will be mailed.

WORKERS: There will be worker signup at mysignup.com. Workers will receive lunch and beverages.

HOTEL INFORMATION: Competitors must contact motels directly and identify themselves as having dogs. PLEASE be a responsible motel guest.

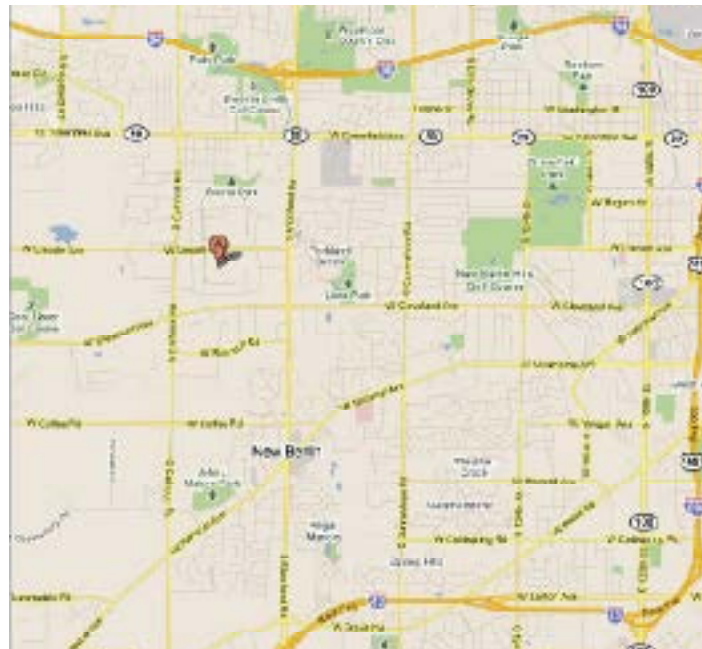

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
