OBEDIENCE JUDGE QUIZ.....WHAT'S YOUR SCORE?

If you are in question please read the following; maybe this will help you with the answers.

Showed competitively in conformation for approximately 20 years, occasionally for the last 9. Obedience for 29 years, very competitively for the last 8. I've been a conformation instructor for 29 years and an obedience instructor for 28. I decided to become an Obedience judge about 8 years ago and have actively pursued it for about 5 years now. It took me about 3 years to complete all the requirements for the Novice class. 10 sanctioned matches, Apprentice judge 3 times with approved AKC judges and a multitude of stewarding assignments. At least 2 references from regularly approved Judges. I applied for provisional status in 2007 and took my written test and interview in August of that same year. During the last 5 years I have also continued to work on completing the requirements for Open & Utility. It will take me approximately 5 more years to become an approved regular judge for all the obedience classes. Total time invested? About 10 to 12 years. That is about the average for anyone interested in becoming an obedience judge.

In order to maintain a uniform and consistent way of judging the AKC is very insistent on continuing education for all judges, provisional and regular. Everyone must attend an AKC sponsored and approved seminar every 3 years.

Having competed at the level I have these past 8 years has helped in knowing and understanding the rules, regulations and ring procedures.

Titles achieved, CD's 8, CDX's, 8, UD's, 2, UDX's 4 (soon to be 5) OM's 2 (Obedience Masters) 3 points away from an OTCH (Obedience Trial Championship), High in Trials 7, High Combined 8

And the answer is - - - - hiding on another page - - - hint October Issue.

According to AKC these are their steps to become a Obedience Judge

- Step 1

Meet the minimum requirements. Application for certification as an obedience judge is eligible to persons who have owned and trained a dog to an AKC Utility Dog (UD) title, and earned an additional Companion Dog (CD) title on another dog. Additionally, applicants need to have been active in the sport for at least 6 years.

- Step 2

Steward at ten AKC obedience trials. Stewards assist the judge with ring management and help the trial run smoothly. They bring equipment in and out of the ring, hold leashes for exhibitors and make sure the next exhibitor is at the gate and ready to enter the ring when called. Stewarding experience teaches the ins and outs of trial management and allows one a close up look at what the judge is doing.

- Step 3

Judge 5 AKC sanctioned matches. These practice shows permit the candidate to judge in a real-life situation but with less pressure than at an actual trial.

- Step 4

Apprentice under 3 different judges. The apprentice gets to practice judging at a real trial under the auspices of an experienced obedience judge. The apprentice works with each judge for one class at a trial, and the class needs to have ten entries in it to qualify.

- Step 5

Teach dog training classes. Those wishing to become obedience judges need to have acted as a trainer or assistant trainer at a dog training club or organization of some kind.

- Step 6

Attend an AKC obedience seminar within three years prior to application. In addition to valuable education about training and competing, these seminars provide up-to-date information about the AKC rules and regulations for competition obedience, which are modified from time to time.

- Step 7

Obtain provisional approval after passing a written test and attending an interview with an AKC Field Representative. After completing 5 judging assignments as a provisional judge and undergoing a successful observation by an AKC-designated observer, provisional judges can apply for regular approval by filing the appropriate form with the AKC.

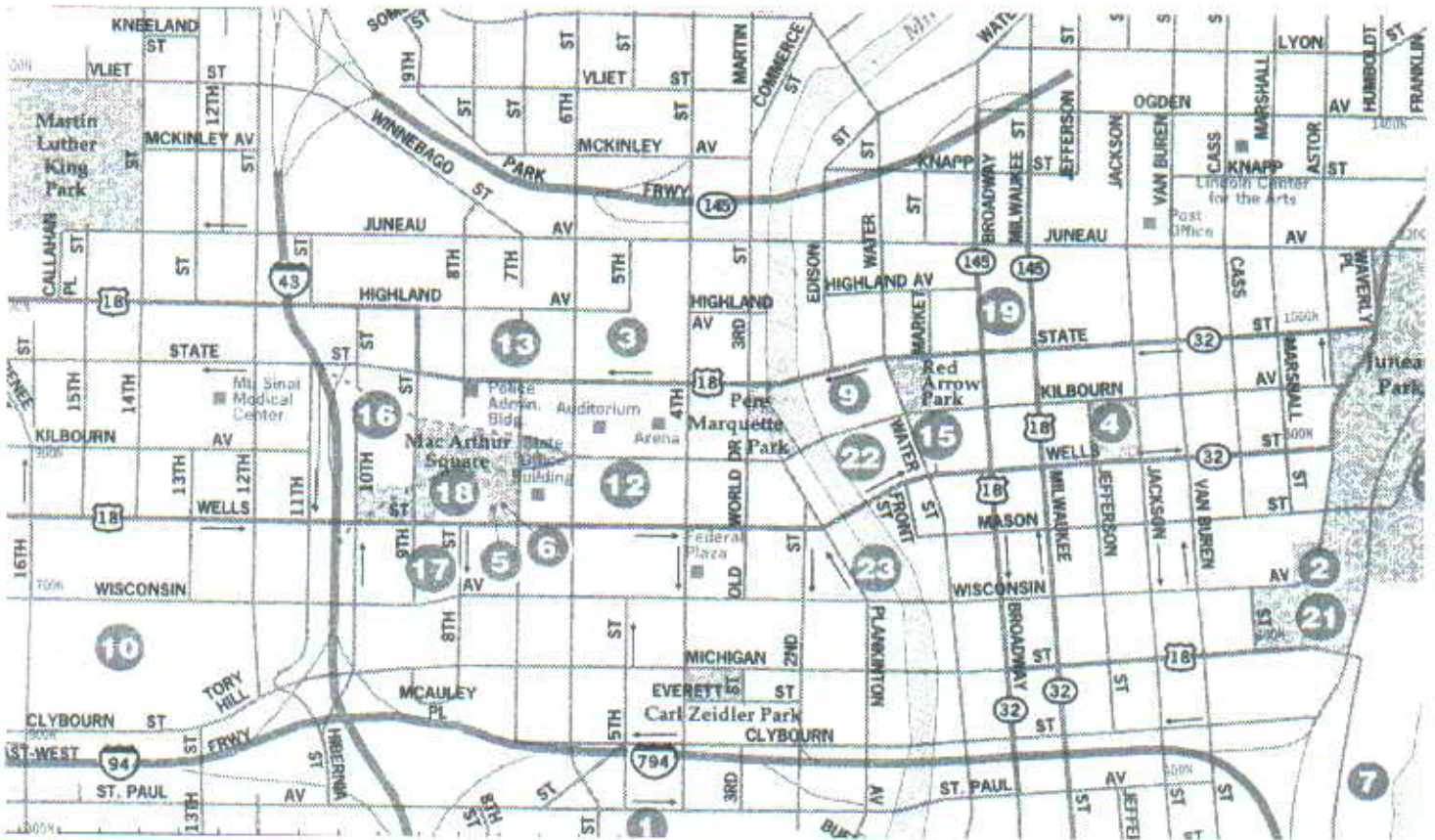

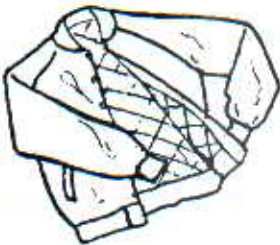
