What's Happening at the Club on June 14 and June 15????

What IS Futurity/Maturity Show?

The German Shepherd Dog Club of Wisconsin has been chosen to host the Midwest Region show; one of 9 regional shows in 2008 sponsored by the German Shepherd Dog Club of America. The show will be held on Sunday, June 15, 2008 at our Club grounds.

A futurity/maturity (similar to a sweepstakes in other breeds) is designed to showcase puppies and young dogs. It is a fancy fun match with classes held by age group. Dogs will come from all over the country to be shown according to the following rules:

"Open to all registered German Shepherd Dogs nominated in accordance with GSDCA rules and whelped (born) during the period between October 1, 2006 and September 30, 2007."

FUTURITY CLASSES:

Juniors: Born July 1 2007 thru September 30, 2007
Teen Age: Born April 1, 2007 thru June 30, 2007
Intermediate: Born Jan 1 2007 thru March 31, 2007
Senior: Born October 1 2006 thru December 31, 2006

MATURITY CLASSES:

Juniors: Born April 1 2006 thru September 30, 2006
Seniors: Born October 1, 2005 thru March 31 2006

No AKC points are awarded but the futurity and maturity winners chosen at our Club are eligible to compete against the other 8 regional winners at the German Shepherd Dog Club of America national Specialty Show for 4 titles: Futurity Victor and Victrix and Maturity Victor and Victrix.

Many of our GSDC-Wisconsin club members have owned dogs that have been regional winners and several have gone on to the Futurity/Maturity Victor/Victrix titles.

Are there Other Events happening on Saturday, June 14?

There will be a regular AKC dog show sponsored by the Topline German Shepherd Dog Club (Illinois), an amateur futurity/maturity show (same requirements for the dogs but no handler may be a professional), and a German Shepherd Dog Club of America Temperament Test (also called a Temperament Certification). Dogs passing this test are eligible to use the title "TC" after their name.

What's a Temperament Test???

The Temperament Test, similar to the AKC Canine Good Citizen (CGC), consists of:

Station 1 - Neutral Stranger

Dog and handler are approached by a neutral stranger who stops and talks to the handler for a moment, ignoring the dog. The dog is graded on its response to the stranger.

Station 2 - Friendly Stranger

The dog and handler are approached by a friendly stranger who stops and talks to the handler for a moment, making friendly advances towards the dog. The dog is graded on its response to the stranger.

Station 3 - Hidden Noise

The dog and handler walk towards a blind that has a person hidden in it. The person in the blind shakes a bucket with bolts/rocks in it then steps out of the blind, puts the object down, and retreats back into the blind. The dog is graded on its reaction to the noise, and willingness to investigate.

Station 4 - Gunshots

The dog and handler stand about 10 feet from a blind that has a person hidden in it. The handler has their back to the blind. The person in the blind fires a starter pistol once. Then after a pause, fires the pistol two more times. The dog is graded on its reaction to the noise.

Station 5 - Umbrella

The dog and handler walk towards a person sitting in a chair. When they are about 5 feet from the tester, the tester opens an umbrella (dog and handler continue to walk forward). The dog is graded on its reaction, recovery time, and willingness to investigate. It must be willing to get within a few inches of the umbrella to pass.

Station 6 - Unusual Surface

The dog and handler walk across a plastic surface (tarp on the ground). The dog is graded on its reaction to the surface and willingness to walk across it.

Station 7 - X-Pen

The dog walks across an x-pen laid out on the ground. The dog is graded on its reaction to the surface and willingness to walk across it.

Station 8 - Weird Stranger

A stranger comes out of a blind and approaches from approx. 40 feet away, dressed in lots of baggy clothes and acting drunk, reeling around and making weird noises. When the stranger is approx. 30 feet away, they begin to act more aggressive, hitting the ground with a stick or riding crop and making more noise. When they are approx. 20 feet away, they retreat back to the blind. The dog is graded on its reaction to the stranger.

To participate, dogs MUST be at least 1 year old. Handlers should be at least 12 years old.

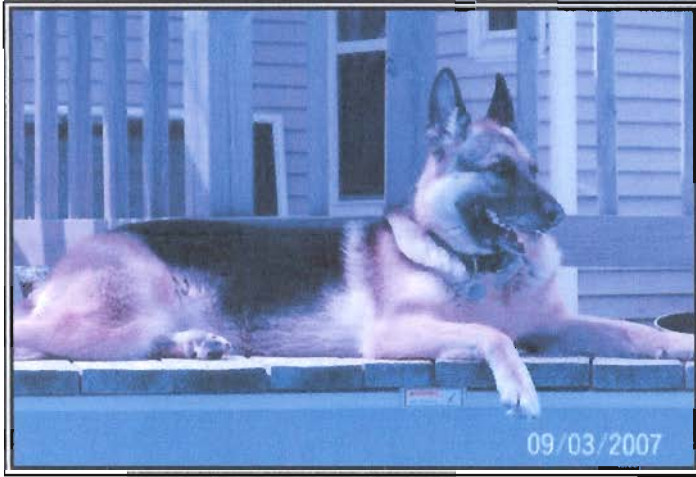

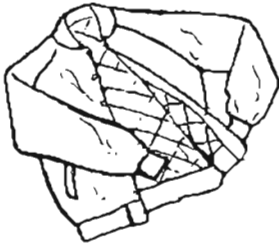
