**The annual H.A.W.S. Walk-a-Thon, May 3rd, 2008.**

**YOU DID IT GSDCW!!!!** Not only did you beat my meager request to beat last year's \$5825 donation, you blew it away by an additional \$845. Congratulations...Job Well Done!

This was our 20<sup>th</sup> year walking for the Waukesha Humane Society and again a Big Thank You to all members who either participated in the walk or donated to a club member. The Humane Society has been extremely appreciative of our club. Since this was their 25<sup>th</sup> Walk-a-Thon and our 20<sup>th</sup>, they asked me to write an article about the club that appeared in their newsletter. At the Walk-a-Thon they put on a little presentation honoring the club and our well behaved dogs. Each dog was presented a "HAWS Hero" medallion and they provided the club a cake celebrating our 20<sup>th</sup> year. As usual, we heard a lot of feedback at the Walk from the H.A.W.S. volunteers and other walkers, saying good things about the club and German Shepherds as a whole and thanking us for our continued support.

Making sure the German Shepherd breed is well thought of in the community is what this is all about.

We had an excellent turnout especially considering that the weather of rain, rain drizzle, then more cold rain put a damper on our normal fun activities. I counted 37-39 people and dogs, the most ever at the Walk-a-Thon. I'm very sorry to say that I will not be able to list the names of all the hearty souls that came out this day, but the rain took care of our carbon paper and only a few names were readable. Including some additional donations that arrived afterward, the GSDCW collected \$6,670 for HAWS; our most ever and cumulatively over the 20 years that puts us at \$72,905. **Another Great Job GSDCW!!!**

Despite the rain, our day started in true GSDCW fashion, with a little morning pick-me-up; Bloody Mary's from Mike & Cathy Los. The HAWS people provided us with one dining canopy initially, we brought in 2 more (Thank you Alan Ohm for figuring out how to assemble them) and we moved another one that wasn't being used. All told, we had 4 dining canopies lined up to keep us and the food dry. We partied under the canopies and a good number of us actually got some walking done during the brief rain interruptions. We had plenty of appetizers and liquid refreshments and did lots of general socializing.

**Overall it was another Successful GSDCW Event!**

Again, big Congratulations and **Thank You** to everyone who helped make this another Great Event! I'm so sorry the list of participants did not survive the rain.

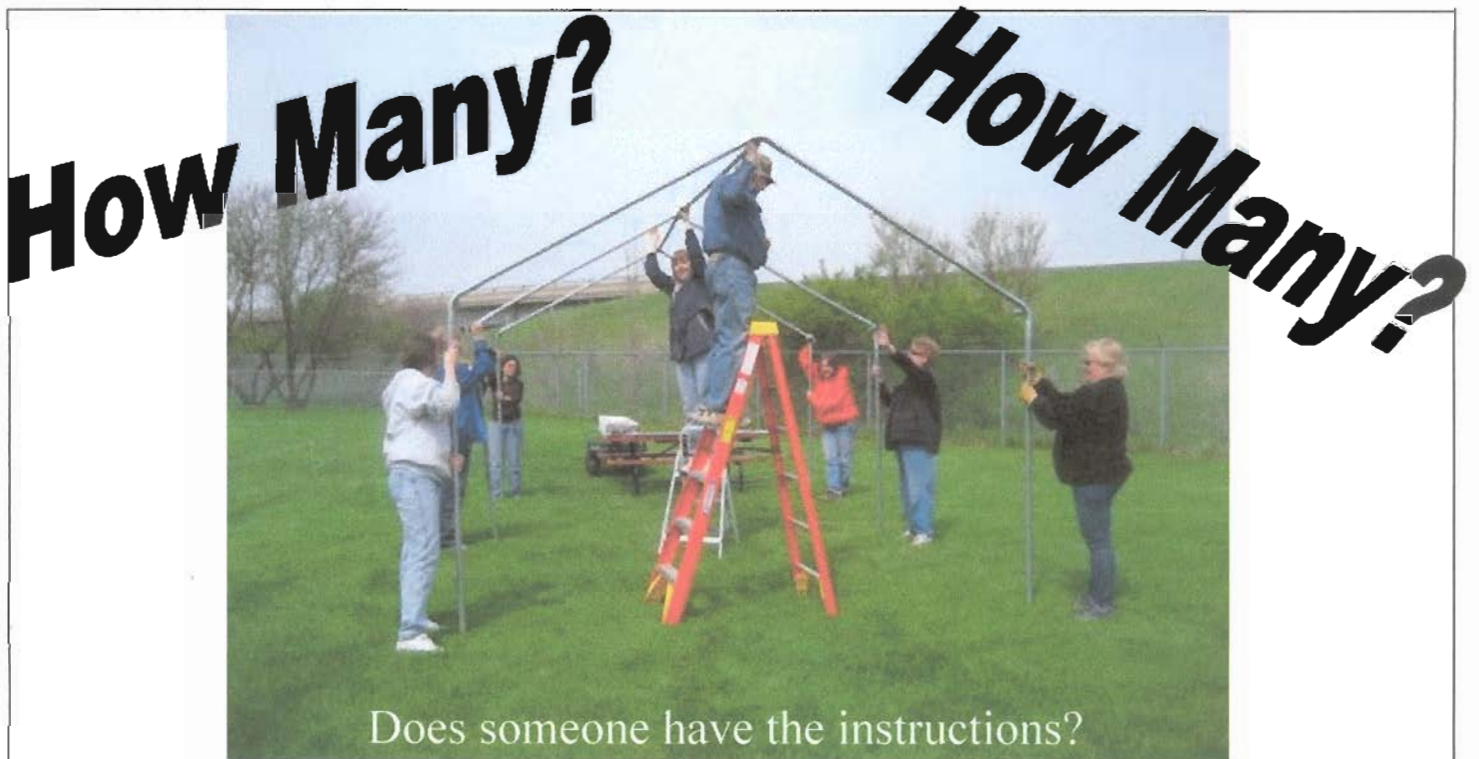

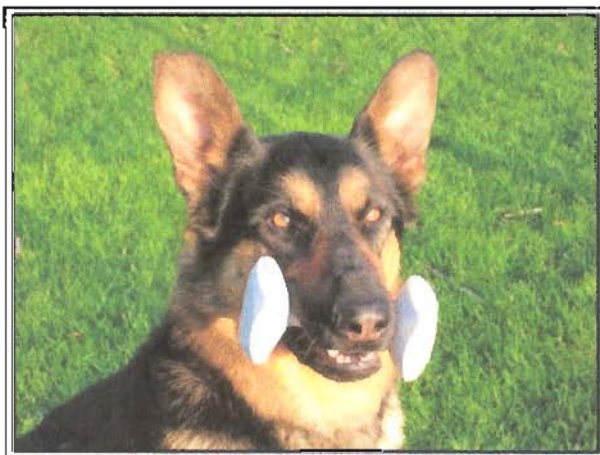
