The existing wall on the east side of the building will not be removed until the concrete is in and the addition is almost done, so we will be training while the addition goes up. It will be a little muddy, so you'll need to go north of the building to walk dogs rather than between the building and the garage for a little while.

BLOOD SAMPLES NEEDED FROM GSDs WITH EXOCRINE PANCREATIC INSUFFICIENCY (EPI)

!

Texas A&M University (TAMU) is conducting Phase II of the EPI Research Study with SNP technology in an effort to identify the complex genetic markers to EPI. They desperately need blood samples from veterinary confirmed GSDs with EPI. GSD pedigrees not required. Shiloh Shepherds and GSD mixes will be tested at a later date.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR EPI RESEARCH

To participate in contributing a blood & serum sample please share these instructions with your vet. Most vets will draw blood free if it is for research. The Fed Ex shipping costs will be paid at this time and the Fed Ex # will be given to you once you contact Dr. Leigh Anne Clark/TAMU for the application: lclark@cvm.tamu.edu.

1. Dog will need to fast 12 hours before the draw.
2. Draw approximately 10ml blood into syringe
3. Fill purple-top with 5-6mls
4. Invert the tube several times after filling
5. Fill red-top tube with remainder of blood
6. Spin blood to separate serum
7. After separation, transfer serum to second red-top tube
8. Please make sure tubes are clearly labeled
9. Return samples in a Styrofoam cooler with a freezer pack.
10. Do not ship on a Friday.

Variety: If you are entering a dog of breed in show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB part-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in, but not exceeding 15 in.), Dalmatians (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (king Charles and Ruby), Bleuberry and Prince Charming, Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in its premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
