Sport service operates 26 permanent concession stands at Miller Park. Each season they contract with Non-Profit Groups to operate some of these stands. It is the Non-Profit's responsibility to provide the personnel needed to operate the stands assigned to them. .

If we participate, The German Shepherd Dog Club would have the opportunity to raise funds and have some fun. Some Club's have earned \$15,000.00 in the Baseball Season. The potential for earning is limited only by the Club's teamwork and commitment to this opportunity.

The German Shepherd Dog Club would need at least 30 people to commit to this project. This would allow a rotation of club members. So, each one of the workers would work about 5 games each season.

- The Club would have to agree to sign a binding contract
- The Club would have to supply the appropriate number of volunteers to run the assigned concessions. Groups consist of 6, 10, or 14 people. If the Club had 14 workers we would have first priority for the premiere locations at Miller Park.
- The Club would have to commit to a minimum of working 10 games throughout the Season.

Sport service would supply:

- Sportservice would supply the Club workers with shirts and picture I.D. Badges. Each worker will be required to buy a hat for \$5.00 each.
- Sportservice would supply Training.
- Sportservice would supply free parking passes for the workers.

This is a great opportunity for the Club to add to our coffers. **However, keep in mind that how much the Club would earn depends on factors such as fan attendance, weather, the number of games we work and our dedication to making this project successful. 2008 was a great year.**

I know we have shows, trials and other Club activities. However, if we start early in the season it won't interfere with our Shows, Trials, and Other Activities. If we have a number of our members, regular and associate, who will work together, everyone, can do both. Club activities and working at Miller Park.

More information will follow when we have enough people who have signed up for this opportunity. Sign up sheets will be on the Club's bulletin board. If you have any questions, please give me a call.

Where have all the volunteers gone?

We live in a world of change and it is affecting all of us. I grew up in a time when self sufficiency and energy was expected to make it in life, but somehow I feel sort of out of place in today's world. It is as though someone turned a switch and all of a sudden everyone is expecting to get paid for everything and anything, whether or not they have done anything worthwhile.

Several years ago a fellow minister came to me asking how it was that our congregation worked so well together getting programs going and accomplishing things while his people were so different, never volunteering for anything. I wanted to tell him it was not because our people were different but because of how they were treated, but then I wimped out and just smiled and let him gripe.

The fact is, volunteers are the greatest asset in any community. They run the youth sports programs, the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, the FHA and FFA, the churches, clubs, humanitarian organizations, and a good part of the schools, hospitals, and community government. If tomorrow there were no volunteers; our community life would be altered significantly over night. In my personal estimation, our volunteer base is probably more important than our local government, or possibly even our national government. What would happen if our government awoke one morning to find that they were bankrupt and could no longer cash a check or pay a bill? I bet we'd find all kinds of grass root organizations carrying on with essential services on a voluntary basis.

There is nothing more powerful than a volunteer with a vision. In fact, our government started out as a group of volunteers, giving their time and advice to govern and provide the essential services of our communities. The result was that those who were the wisest and who were motivated by the willingness to give of themselves were the ones who were followed. It was work, pure and simple. The Will to Power had little to do with politics, when there was nothing to gain other than a pat on the back and the satisfaction of community service. I suspect things are not the same anymore.

There are pockets of our community life together that do have those old elements of volunteers who are motivated by a vision for service and which rely on the services of good people, doing their best to make things work for the good of the whole. The German Shepherd Dog Club of America is one such organization among many. Here, the power of the club is not held in a central office of professionals, or in the officers who serve on the Board of Directors, themselves volunteers. The real power of the organization is in the movers and shakers who are in the trenches, serving on committees, and answering phones all across the nation and taking time out of their day or after work in the evening to do the tasks that have to be done to make this rather extensive enterprise work.

From our President, to the Treasurer, right on down through the Membership Chair, all the committees to the members of the local regional clubs, everyone serves with no pay, no badge of political power and no rewards other than the occasional 'thank you' and the joy of knowing that they have contributed to the future of our great breed, The German Shepherd Dog. I think our

professional government could learn a lot from our dog club.

Periodically the issue is raised of why we do not have a national office building and a paid staff to do the essential work? Certainly there is enough work to justify it. But that proposal has always failed simply because there is great value in the work of the volunteer and there is great satisfaction knowing that we can pursue our sports and our hobby without the cost becoming greater than it already is. Can you imagine paying for all of the hours that are given by all of the officers, committee chairs, committee members, and regional clubs?

I have heard some frustrated volunteers, when they are treated as though they should drop going to work, tending to the children and making dinner to solve some problem dumped on them. Sometimes we fail to understand that when we call the national office of problem solving, we are talking to a mom in a kitchen somewhere in Americana, who has a litter of puppies to tend, a neighbor yelling over the fence to keep the dogs quiet and four children wondering what's for dinner. Or maybe we are talking to a dad who just arrived home to this scene and is trying to find a safe place to sit down to talk to us.

Ah, the volunteer: They come in all sizes and shapes, male and female, and live from sea to shining sea. Some are fortunate to have a comfortable means of support and then, in these economic times, some are unemployed. Some are Republicans and some Democrats, some Jewish and some Christian, but there is something above them that allows them to forget their differences and to focus on the task at hand and the purpose for which we exist - the betterment of our breed and the sport of the pure bred dog.

Here's to the volunteers! Without them, this club would not exist, nor would much of the infrastructure of any community across this land. They are the backbone of community, the light that points the way and the hope of our country's future. Get ready! Next time you are asked to help or to take a role in your club or to run for office, do it. The pay is lousy, but the rewards are enormous.

GSDCW Building Addition Status

The building is up & the concrete poured! The building itself is essentially complete to our original plans other than installing the window in the door. There is a photo gallery showing the progress of the addition at www.gsdcw.com.

More grading remains. We are waiting on road restrictions to be lifted so that they can finish the grading and haul the rest of the dirt away. A sidewalk between the building and the garage and a stoop outside the new door will be poured with the finish grading.

We need some additional (some expensive) things not covered in the building contract. We still need:

- A new furnace for heating the addition (we are getting estimates right now). We need to complete a plan for this in order to get occupancy from the Town.
- Paneling for the side walls, overhead lights, and fans
- A lot of grass seed
- Rubber flooring for the addition (we're asking the same company for an estimate)

We wish to thank those who have donated to the addition fund. So far, members of this Club have contributed more than \$8,000, almost half way toward our goal of \$20,000. Applause and gratitude to the following members:

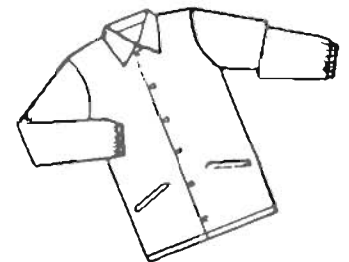

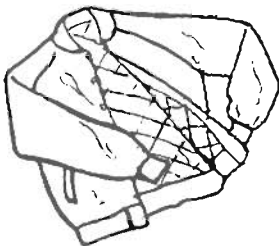
